Winter 84-85. - Mostly just locations & lists, but a few numbers for areas visited more than once (e.g. Phulchowki, Nagarjung) or where I stayed a while (i.e. Koshi) or both (Chitwan).

I haven't highlighted the more unusual records @ because in '83/84 I didn't want to overshadow the other stuff and you would probably be more adept at picking out the less usual stuff as you are more aware of species status. I have however included notes on very rare species - as in some you would want to know the details.

SCAUP. Phewatal 8th Feb

♀ type; associated with a ♀ Tufted Duck on the shore edge at eastern end of lake; - from Tufted Duck, longer, Bill bluer looking, Pectoral brown body & head, pale cheek patches cutting edge, less extensive black tip (no 'jowl'). Prominent white face band, back of head rounded, showing some color as flanks (on Tufted ~~breast~~ breast intermediate between color of head and pectoral flanks)

Pied Wheatear Tukche 11th Jan

Winter ♂. Much like a Eastern Pied Wheatear seen a couple of weeks previously, but appeared smaller & slimmer, more like a Wheatear or Black eared Wheatear in shape. Dull brownish black above, blacker on throat, paler slightly on epw, this area instead washed with dull orange flight feathers & mantle fringed brown. White rump & much white in tail.

GRASSHOPPER WARBLER

Probable 11/4 1 or 2 definite 13/4

Meghalai: Meekan:

Basically Olive brown above, yellowish buff below. Throat thin black shaft streaks from crown to rump. Tertials and wing coverts marked with brown, giving contrasting appearance to upperparts. (Although not as contrasting as long) long thin supercilium from bill to end of ear coverts. Tail (although damp) showed growth bars on central feathers and no paling at tip (cf. P.G.T.Ps). Pink legs, pale flesh lower mandibl. Rump not obviously brighter than mantle (again cf. P.G.T.Ps).

If you would like any further descriptions, or numbers for stuff let me know, alternatively, if you find any of the records dodgy I would also be interested!






