✓ Little Cormorant c 90 at Kosi, 8.4.

✓ Spot-billed Pelican 12 at Kosi, 9.4.

✓ Yellow Bittern 1 at Kosi, 8.4.
Also verbal reports of one about a month previously, so its status as a summer visitor may need to be revised.

Booted Eagle 1 (dark), Swayambunath, 12.4.

✓ Ibisbill 2 already present above Kyaigjin, 1.4.

Grey-headed Plover 1 or 2 at Kosi, 8.4.

Indian Roller 1, Craucher Forest, 12.4.

Golden-throated Barbet 1, Phulchowki, 27.3.

✓ Blyth's Pipit 1 seen and heard at Kosi, 8.4. I have discussed this bird with Steve Madge who agreed that it was probably Blyth's. Several A.n. richardi present on this date.

- White-browed Wagtail 1 feeding a single fledged juv. near Gokarna, 7.4.
- Maroon-backed Acceptor 6 between Lovely Cottage and Shabru (Langtang trek), 3.4.
- Western Crowned Warbler 1 at Swayambar, 24.3.
- Little Pied Flycatcher 1M, Phulchowki, 6.4. This individual did not strike me as being familiar to Grey Bushchat - it was very distinctive!
- Asian Paradise Flycatcher 1 white M near Trisuli, 5.4.
- White-tailed Nuthatch A pair visiting nest-hole between Lovely Cottage and Shabru, 3.4.
- Yellow-bellied Flowerpecker 1 at the bottom of Phulchowki, 13.4.
- Bank Mynah 1 with other Mynahs beside Bagmati (near university), 24.3.

Gold-naped Finch 2M + 1F between Lovely
Cottage and Shabru, 3.4.

Little Bunting c30 below Shabru, 30.8.
