

VOYAGE AU NEPAL - MARS 1987

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ITINERAIRE ET METEO

- 8.03: **Dacca** (Bangladesh) puis arrivée à **Khatmandou**. Beau (23-25°C à Dacca, 18°C à Khat.), puis pluie orageuse en fin de journée.
- 9.03: **Godaveri Botanical Gardens** et environs (fourrés de régénération, cultures). 18°C, beau, qqs nuages (averses le soir).
- 10.03: **Khatmandou-Pokhara** (avion), puis départ pour **Narayangath**. Nuages et soleil mais orages et pluies ++ l'après-midi.
- 11.03: **Narayangath-Meghauli (Chitwan)**, ballade le long de **Rapti River**. Beau, chaud.
- 12.03: **Chitwan N.P.**, ballade dans la forêt alluviale et zone d'herbes à éléphants. Orage la nuit, nbx averses jusqu'à 15:00, éclaircies ensuite.
- 13.03: **Chitwan N.P.**; ballade vers **Tiger Tops** (forêt de sal). Nuages et soleil.
- 14.03: **Meghauli-Narayangath** puis bus vers **Pokhara**. nuageux.
- 15.03: forêt de **Begnas Tal** (avion Jomoson annulé). Soleil, nuageux 1'AM, chaud.
- 16.03: colline au sud de **Pokhara**. Nuages et soleil, orage - pour changer - le soir.
- 17.03: départ Jomoson Trek: jeep de **Pokhara** à **Suiket (Phedi)** puis **Phedi-Naudanda-Khare-Lumle-Chandrakot** (4h). Nuages et soleil, orage à Naudanda, puis brume et vent.
- 18.03: **Chandrakot-Birethanti-Tirkedunghe-Ulleri** (2075m) - 1562m de dénivellation, environ 7h de marche. Nuageux et soleil (nuages d'orage).
- 19.03: **Ulleri-Nayanthanti-Ghorepani** (2850m - 4h de marche - 780m déniv.). Soleil et nuages. Forêt de Rhododendrons, particulièrement belle au-dessus d'Ulleri.
- 20.03: autour de **Ghorepani**, trek Ouest puis **Ghorepani-Chitre** (2316m - 1h - 537m déniv.) Neige le matin puis soleil et nuages, un peu de pluie, mais plutôt frais. Visite de la **vallée de Chitre**.
- 21.03: **Chitre-Tatopani** (1189m - 1h30 - 1127m déniv.), puis **Tatopani-Dana-Balebas-Kapchepani-Ghasa** (2012m - 4h30 - 823m déniv.). Soleil et nuages et un peu de pluie le soir.
- 22.03: **Ghasa-Lete-Kalopani** (2530m - 2h30 - 2686m déniv.), ballade au-dessus de **Ghasa** jusqu'à 3200m. Nuages et soleil, qqs gouttes le soir.
- 23.03: **Kalopani-Larjung-Tukuche** (3h) -**Marpha-Jomoson** (2713m - 3h - 173m déniv. totale). Soleil, vent violent en altitude à partir de 12h00.
- 24.03: **Jomoson-Kagbeni** (2h30) -**Kingar** (2h) -**Muktinath** (3802m - 1h30 - 1089m déniv.) - Soleil, moins venteux que la veille.
- 25.03: ballade autour de **Muktinath**, puis **Muktinath-Kagbeni-Jomoson-Marpha** (2667m - 4h30 env. - 1135m déniv.). Soleil puis vent fort (7-8BF) dans la **Kali Kandaki**. Gris, qqs gouttes à Marpha.
- 26.03: "repos" à **Marpha**: ballade au-dessus du village dans une vieille junipéraie clairsemée (ressemblant à la pinède à crochets). Nuageux pluies pluies légères de 10:30 à 14:00, clame ensuite. (forêt à env. 2950m, 280m déniv.).

27.03: Marpha-Tukuche-Kalopani (5h-5h30 - 137m déniv.). arrivée à 2530m. Nuages et soleil, vent 4+ l'A.M. se calmant en soirée.

28.03: Kalopani-Lete-Ghasa-Balebas-Tatopani (1100m - 7h - 1341m déniv.). Arrêt après Lete (obs). Nuages et soleil, léger vent dans la Kali Kandaki.

29.03: Tatopani-Ghorepani (2853m - 8h - 1664m déniv.). Montée difficile sur Ghara à cause de la chaleur. Soleil, puis couvert dans l'a.m. et qqs gouttes en fin de journée.

30.03: Ghorepani-Ulleri (2h30) -Birethanti (1037m - 2h40 - 1816m déniv.). Soleil puis nuages d'orage l'a.m.

31.03: Birethanti-Chandrakoth (1h30) -Naudanda (2h10) -Phedi (20') puis jeep (1h) pour Pokhara (915m). Soleil le matin puis nuageux avec orage violent vers 14:30 avec pluie +++ et grelons. Départ en bus pour Khatmandu.

1.04: ballade à Gokarna et Gaucher Forest ainsi qu'en ville (Patshupatinath). Soleil, chaud.

2.04: courses en ville, puis départ pour Dacca et la France. Arrivée à Paris le 3.04 vers 11h00 (HL)
