I hope the records will be helpful and send them to you in response to your request in OBC Bulletin 18, hope, soon for I have also include (two what I loosely term 'sketch') drawings. The white was the twin individual and is distinct from my note book, the other is an ~~or~~ yet unidentified and is a copy from my notebook. I originally believed it to be Snowy Browed Blyth's.
