0011	<b>Snow Partridge</b> <i>Lerwa lerwa</i>	4 of this fairly common resident species were seen above Kyangjin Gompa on 3 May and c10 were heard below the Laurebina Pass on 9 May
0020	<b>Black Francolin</b> <i>Francolinus francolinus</i>	3 vocal birds were seen in scrub at Godaveri on 26 May with 1 heard from tall grass at Syabru on 28 May and several heard there on 29 May
0039	<b>Hill Partridge</b> <i>Arborophila torqueola</i>	A partridge flushed on Phulchowki on 27 April was probably this species. Birds were heard btwn Syabru & Changtang [6 May]; btwn Chandan Bari & Gosainkund [8th] btwn Thare Pati & Khutumsang [11th]; btwn Chisopani & Sheopuri [13th]; and at Sheopuri on 14 May
0064	<b>Blood Pheasant</b> <i>Ithaginis cruentus</i>	A covey of 9 birds at Ghopte on 10 May and a pair with one chick near to Thare Pati on 11 May
0066	<b>Satyr Tragopan</b> <i>Tragopan satyra</i>	2 birds were heard calling from the forest above our camp site at Chandan Bari on 6 May and two shy and wary birds were seen there during the early morning of the 7 May. Another was heard at Ghopte on 10 May
0071	<b>Himalayan Monal</b> <i>Lophophorus impejanus</i>	1 heard calling at Ghore Tabela on 1 May and 4 seen on grassy slopes above the treeline, en route to Langtang Village later that day. Singletons were seen at Langtang Village on the 2 May and at Ghopte on 9 May, with one calling bird there on 10 May
0078	<b>Kalij Pheasant</b> <i>Lophura leucomelanos</i>	4 on lower Phulchowki on 25 April, with 2 there on 27 May; 1 displaying male btwn Dhunche and Sherpa Lodge on 29 April; 2 btwn Chhunama and Sherpa Lodge on 5 May; several noted on Sheopuri on 14 May. Two of the three intergrading races were noted

0203	<b>Brown-fronted Woodpecker</b> <i>Dendrocopos auriceps</i>	<b>1 between the Sherpa Lodge and Syabru on 29 April; 2 between Syabru and Bamboo Lodge on 30 April; and 5 between Landslide Lodge and Syabru on 5 May</b>
0204	<b>Fulvous-breasted Woodpecker</b> <i>Dendrocopos macei</i>	<b>Just 1 at the Royal Botanical Gardens, Godaveri on 26 April</b>
0207	<b>Rufous-bellied Woodpecker</b> <i>Dendrocopos hyperythrus</i>	<b>3 on Phulchowki, where it is regularly seen, on 25 April</b>
0209	<b>Darjeeling Woodpecker</b> <i>Dendrocopos darjellensis</i>	<b>Singletons were seen on the lower slopes of Phulchowki on 27 April; between Changtang and Ghore Tabela on 1 May; near Chhunama on 4 May; and at Sheopuri on 13 May. Additionally 2 were noted at Chhunama on 5 May</b>
0228	<b>Scaly-bellied Woodpecker</b> <i>Picus squamatus</i>	<b>The only record, of a single bird; came from Chandan Bari on 7 May</b>

0254	<b>Great Barbet</b> <i>Megalaima virens</i>	Calling birds on Phulchowki on 26 April; btwn Dhunche and Syabru 29 April; btwn Syabru & Changtang 30 April; and btwn Chisapani & Sheopuri 13 May. Singles were seen btwn Syabru and Bamboo Lodge 30 April and btwn Khutumsang and Chisapani 12 May
0266	<b>Golden-throated Barbet</b> <i>Megalaima franklinii</i>	2 were heard on Phulchowki on 25 April and 1 - 2 were seen there on 26 and 27 April. 2 other birds were seen between Chhunama and Syabru on 5 May
0268	<b>Blue-throated Barbet</b> <i>Megalaima asiatica</i>	1 - 2 birds were seen at Godaveri Botanical Gardens on 26 April; at Godaveri Village on 27 April; and between Kathmandu and Dhunche on 28 April. Other calling birds were heard at Godaveri on 27 April and also at Sheopuri on 14 May
0309	<b>Common Hoopoe</b> <i>Upupa epops</i>	1 in the grounds of the Hotel Himalaya, Patan on 24 April
0319	<b>Red-headed Trogon</b> <i>Harpactes erythrocephalus</i>	1 was seen and heard calling approximately half-way up Phulchowki on 26 April
0345	<b>White-throated Kingfisher</b> <i>Halycon smyrnensis</i>	2 were noted during the long road journey from Kathmandu to Dhunche Bazaar on 28 April
0376	<b>Chestnut-headed Bee-eater</b> <i>Merops leschenaulti</i>	2 seen during the mini-bus journey between Kathmandu and Dhunche Bazaar on 28 April and a singleton seen towards the end of the trek

0380	<b>Large Hawk Cuckoo</b> <i>Hierococcyx sparverioides</i>	At least 5 seen or heard daily in Kathmandu Valley and on almost every day during the trek, with a maxima of 20 between Chisapani and Sheopuri on 13 May
0384	<b>Indian Cuckoo</b> <i>Cuculus micropterus</i>	Several heard near to Khutumsang on 12 May
0385	<b>Eurasian Cuckoo</b> <i>Cuculus canorus</i>	Up to 3 seen or heard daily in Kathmandu Valley with up to 5 on many days during the trek
0386	<b>Oriental Cuckoo</b> <i>Cuculus saturatus</i>	Slightly fewer than the last species, with a daily maximum of 3 seen or heard, mostly seen, both in Kathmandu Valley and on the trek
0387	<b>Lesser Cuckoo</b> <i>Cuculus poliocephalus</i>	1 showy, noisy individual on Phulchowki on 27 April; 1 near to Sherpa Lodge en route to Syabru on 29 April; 1 near Syabru on 30 April; singletons were heard or seen daily during 6 - 10 May, at various sites between Syabru and Thare Pati
0390	<b>Grey-bellied Cuckoo</b> <i>Cacomantis passerinus</i>	A single bird showed well near to Dhunche on 29 April and 1 was heard between the Himalaya Guest House and Chisapani on 12 May
0508	<b>Himalayan Swiftlet</b> <i>Collocalia brevirostris</i>	Feeding flocks of up to 30 of this fairly common resident were seen at many locations e.g., Syabru, Chantang, Chhunama, Chandan Bari, Thare Pati and Khutumsang

0527	<b>Fork-tailed Swift <i>Apus pacificus</i></b>	20 - 30 at Dhunche on 28 and 29 April, a flock of 50 between Syabru and Chandan Bari on 6 May with a few noted between Phedi and Ghopte on 9 May then c40 near to Khutumsang on 11 May with just 4 en route to Chisapani on 12 May
0529	<b>House Swift <i>Apus affinis</i></b>	A common resident with feeding flocks of up to 300 noted in Kathmandu and smaller numbers at Dhunche
0584	<b>Collared Owlet <i>Glaucidium brodiei</i></b>	1 showed well near to Syabru on 5 May and two were heard calling between Chisapani and Sheopuri on 13 May
0585	<b>Asian Barred Owlet <i>Glaucidium cuculoides</i></b>	A singleton perched outside the Royal Botanical Gardens at Godaveri on 26 April
0618	<b>Grey Nightjar <i>Caprimulgus indicus</i></b>	Only heard at Dhunche on 28 April
0631	<b>Rock Pigeon <i>Columba livia</i></b>	Small numbers noted daily in the Kathmandu Valley and at Syabru on 30 April
0633	<b>Snow Pigeon <i>Columba leuconota</i></b>	A few birds were noted near to Langtang Village on 1 May then up to 250 birds were seen daily during 2 - 4 May en route to and around Kyangjin Gumpa and during the return journey to Langtang Village

0637	<b>Speckled Wood Pigeon</b> <i>Columba hodgsonii</i>	Between 3 - 6 recorded at Syabru on 29 and 30 April and 6 May, at Chhunama on 4 May and at Chandan Bari on 7 May
0638	<b>Ashy Wood Pigeon</b> <i>Columba pulchricollis</i>	Just 2 certain birds were seen at Chandan Bari on 8 May
0650	<b>Oriental Turtle Dove</b> <i>Streptopelia orientalis</i>	Fairly common and widespread with a maximum of 26 between Khutumsang and Chisopani on 12 May. Recorded in Kathmandu Valley, and between Dhunche and Syabru, in the Langtang Valley as far as Langtang Village, and at Chandan Bari and Sheopuri
0652	<b>Spotted Dove</b> <i>Streptopelia chinensis</i>	Fairly common in Kathmandu Valley with 3 near to Dhunche on 29 April
0692	<b>Wedge-tailed Green Pigeon</b> <i>Treron sphenura</i>	9 near to Syabru on 30 April and 3 near Sherpa Lodge on 5 May were the only sightings of this locally fairly common resident
0773	<b>White-breasted Waterhen</b> <i>Amaurionis phoenicurus</i>	A surprise bird was seen at 12,000 feet, walking quickly through some scrub by a pool below a birch, juniper and rhododendron forest, across the valley from Kyangjin on 2 May
0802	<b>Solitary Snipe</b> <i>Gallinago solitaria</i>	1 flushed several times from a ditch near the site of the old air strip in the upper Langtang Valley on 3 May

0865	<i>Ibisbill Ibidorhyncha struthersii</i>	7 were seen at <i>Kyangjin</i> ; in the upper <i>Langtang Valley</i> on the 3 May
0970	<i>Black Kite Milvus migrans</i>	Abundant in <i>Kathmandu Valley</i> with 1 possible migrant on 12 May between <i>Khutumsang</i> and <i>Chisapani</i>
0978	<i>Lammergeier Gypaetus barbatus</i>	2 at <i>Kyangjin</i> on 2 May with 1 there the following day, 1 between <i>Chhunama</i> and <i>Sherpa Lodge</i> on 5 May, 1 en route to <i>Gosainkund</i> on 8 May, and 2 at both <i>Phedi</i> and <i>Ghopte</i> on 9 May
0979	<i>Egyptian Vulture Neophron percnopterus</i>	Just 1 was seen at <i>Khutumsang</i> on 11 May during a mini raptor movement
0982	<i>Himalayan Griffon Gyps himalayensis</i>	1 on <i>Phulchowki</i> on 25 April, 3 at <i>Kyangjin</i> on both 3 and 4 May and 1 at <i>Gosainkund</i> on 9 May
0983	<i>Eurasian Griffon Vulture Gyps fulvus</i>	A singleton on <i>Phulchowki</i> on 25 April, 4 between <i>Kathmandu</i> and <i>Dhunche</i> on 28 April and 20 at <i>Khutumsang</i> on 11 May
0985	<i>Red-headed Vulture Sarcogyps calvus</i>	The only record concerned a distant flying bird at <i>Khutumsang</i> on 11 May

1009	<b>Besra</b> <i>Accipiter virgatus</i>	1 - 2 were on Phulchowki on 25 and at the Royal Botanical Gardens Godaveri on the 26 April, at Ghore Tabela on 1 May, on the lower slopes of the forest across from Kyangjin Gomba on 2 May and at Chandan Bari on 7 May
1014	<b>Northern Goshawk</b> <i>Accipiter gentilis</i>	1 at Ghore Tabela on 1 May
1019	<b>Common Buzzard</b> <i>Buteo buteo</i>	2 at Kyangjin on 2 May with singletons at Sing Gomba on 7 May, between Chandan Bari and Gosainkund on 8 May and near Phedi on 9 May
1021	<b>Upland Buzzard</b> <i>Buteo hemilasius</i>	2 were well-watched at 3840 metres en route to Gosainkund on 8 May and 2 were seen between Phedi and Ghopte on 9 May

1324	<b>Red-billed Chough</b> <i>Pyrrhocorax pyrrhocorax</i>	Flocks of up to 10 birds noted around Kyangjin during 2 - 4 May
1325	<b>Yellow-billed Chough</b> <i>Pyrrhocorax graculus</i>	Between 50 and 100 were recorded daily at Kyangjin during the 2 - 4 May
1328	<b>House Crow</b> <i>Corvus splendens</i>	Abundant and sedentary resident in Kathmandu Valley

1362	<b>Maroon Oriole</b> <i>Oriolus traillii</i>	Single birds on Phulchowki on 25 and 26 April, between Sherpa Lodge and Syabru on 29 April, between Syabru and Changtang on 30 April, near to Sherpa Lodge on 5 May and between Chisapani and Sheopuri on 13 May
1393	<b>Black-winged Cuckooshrike</b> <i>Coracina melaschistos</i>	Just one recorded between Landslide Lodge and Syabru on 5 May
1412	<b>Long-tailed Minivet</b> <i>Pericrocotus ethologus</i>	Widespread and fairly common with up to 12 seen daily in Kathmandu Valley and between 10 and 2 noted at various places during the trek
1415	<b>Scarlet Minivet</b> <i>Pericrocotus flammeus</i>	One sighting of 2 birds near to Dhunche on 29 April
1418	<b>Yellow-bellied Fantail</b> <i>Rhipidura hypoxantha</i>	No more than 3 noted on any one day in Kathmandu Valley, with 8 between Sunset View Lodge and Chandan Bari on 6 May and at Chandan Bari on 7 May. 4 were seen at Ghopte on 10 May 5 between Thare Pati and Khutumsang on 11 May

1442	<b>Lesser Racket-tailed Drongo</b> <i>Dicurus remifer</i>	2 on Phulchowki on 27 April and 1 between Chisapani and Sheopuri on 13 May

1502	<b>Orange-headed Thrush</b> <i>Zoothera citrina</i>	2 were enjoyed at Godaveri on 26 April and 3 were seen there on 27 April
1507	<b>Plain-backed Thrush</b> <i>Zoothera mollissima</i>	3 between Gosainkund and Phedi on 9 May and 2 near to Thare Pati on 11 May
1508	<b>Long-tailed Thrush</b> <i>Zoothera dixonii</i>	1 was well-watched at Sheopuri on 14 May
1509	<b>Scaly Thrush</b> <i>Zoothera dauma</i>	2 on Phulchowki on 25 April, with 6 there on the 26 and 27 April; up to 4 at Chandan Bari on 7 - 8 May and similar numbers at Sheopuri on 14 May

1550	<b>Rusty-tailed Flycatcher</b> <i>Muscicapa ruficauda</i>	An uncommon summer visitor and passage migrant. 2 between Langtang Village and Chhunama on 4 May and 4 at Chandan Bari on 6 and 7 May
