Centre for Nepal and Asian Studies (CNAS) has been publishing *Contributions to Nepalese Studies* for the last 30 years. Of these 30 volumes, it has published 64 regular issues and 5 special issues on coronation, health, fertility, Silver Jubilee and Jirel. These volumes include 450 articles and 102 book-reviews.

With a view to facilitating the users of *Contributions to Nepalese Studies* to access the articles or book-reviews of their interest by subject or by author, a bibliography has been published time and again in the journal itself. The first bibliography appeared in Volume 12, Number 3 and later in Volume 23, Number No.1. This present bibliography includes articles and book reviews published in Volume 23, Number 2 to Volume 30, Number 2, which count up to 109 articles and 22 book reviews.
